<b>EQUIPMENT:</b>	All athletes’ helmets must conform to the FIS helmet rules as outlined under section 5. Crash Helmets, FIS specifications for competition equipment. Ski specific, FIS conformed helmets (label “RH2013”) MUST be used for GS events, no exception.  Back protection is mandatory for all athletes in the form of a back protector. No chin guards or pole guards allowed. Athletes not adhering to the preceding rules will be categorized Not Permitted to Start (NPS).  GS skis recommended.
