Race registration and bib pick up will begin at 8:00 am in the race clubhouse  <i>Note: \$100 bib replacement fee will be charged for any bibs that are lost or damaged.</i>

<b>VOLUNTEERS:</b>	<b>Clubs are requested to supply 1 volunteer for every 2 racers entered for each day.</b> Volunteers must have a minimum Level 1 Officials Certification and be fully registered with <a href="http://Alpine Canada">Alpine Canada</a> . Names and work preferences must be submitted on-line with race registration ( <u>emailing volunteer names to race secretary will not be accepted</u> ). It is the responsibility of each Club to ensure all race officials are certified with ACA and insured with Alpine SK prior to the event.
<b>LUNCH:</b>	Provided for volunteers, coaches, and ski patrol on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday at the race clubhouse.

<b>LIFT TICKETS:</b>	<p>Lift passes will be purchased on behalf of the competitors and coaches and distributed with the bib packages. Complimentary lift passes will be provided for the volunteers. Volunteers are to pick up their lift pass at the registration table. Each team will receive two complimentary coach passes. The competitor, coach, and volunteer names requiring lift passes must be listed on the event participation list to receive a ticket. No refunds will be granted.
