

SASKTEL Classic CHALLENGE CUP

On Feb 7, 2026 the 20th Annual SaskTel Classic will take place at Mission Ridge Winter Park. The events proceeds will be presented to the Regina Ski Club Alpine Adaptive Ski Program (RAASP).

As a Regina and District business, you and your company are invited to participate in this fun and worthwhile event by entering one or more teams. Your team will consist of four of your staff (male or female) and the 5th member will be a skier with a disability, from your staff or chosen by the RAASP. The race will be held on the bunny hill, so all skiing abilities can participate. The ski/snowboard race will be a dual slalom format, with teams going head-to-head with their opposition.

Each team member entered will receive the following:

- Take home participation award
- Buffet Lunch
- All day lift ticket
- Ski equipment daily rental including helmet (if you do not have your own equipment)
- Après Ski beer token

THE SASKTEL CLASSIC CHALLENGE CUP RULES

The race format is a dual race, with total team times for both morning run and afternoon run added together for the final total team time. This means that each member of your team races down the course, once in the red course and once in the blue course, all your member's times will be added together for your total team time. The fastest total team time wins Gold, 2nd fastest time wins Silver and 3rd fastest wins Bronze.

Special categories such as "fastest individual time", "best wipe out of the day", and "best team spirit".

Ski helmets are mandatory and must be worn by all racers.

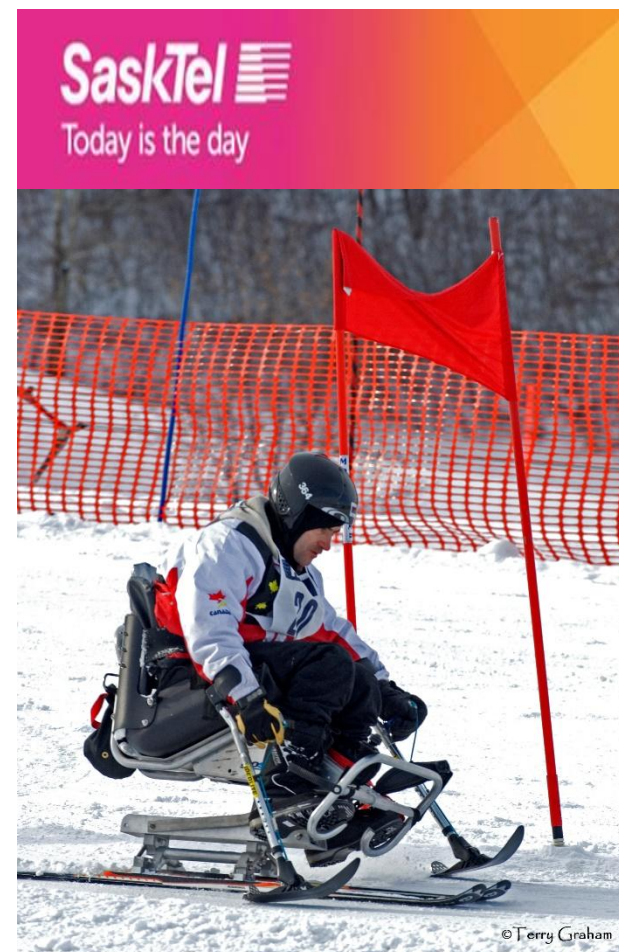
