Alpine Saskatchewan (Sask Alpine), the Provincial Sport Governing Body for alpine skiing in Saskatchewan, is seeking a High-Performance Head Coach to lead the development and execution of elite athlete and coach development programs across the province.

Position: High Performance Head Coach
Location: Saskatchewan (residency required or willingness to relocate)
Term: 2-Year consecutive contract (with potential for renewal)
Dates: November 1, 2025 – April 30th (6 month/year)

Sask Alpine governs and supports both competitive and developmental alpine skiing in Saskatchewan. Our mission is to foster a positive environment that develops athletes, coaches, and ski clubs through collaborative programming, technical excellence, and a clear highperformance pathway.

Key Responsibilities

- Lead and oversee the Saskatchewan Alpine High-Performance Team, ensuring alignment with Alpine Canada's Long-Term Athlete Development model.
- Design and implement annual training and competition plans, including dryland, onsnow, and camp programs.
- Mentor and provide technical guidance to coaches across the province, with a focus on ongoing coach development and certification.
- Collaborate with local clubs to support athlete identification, recruitment, and progression from grassroots to elite levels (FIS, CWG, and national competitions).
- Work closely with Saskatchewan Alpine's Athletic Manager to plan calendars, travel, training camps and race support.
- Work with the Board to develop and execute strategic goals for the High-Performance stream and team selection.
- Represent Alpine Saskatchewan at inter-provincial collaborative events.
- Maintain strong communication and relationships with athletes, families, club leaders, officials, and external stakeholders.



Qualifications

- Performance-Level (PL Certified) Coach. Saskatchewan Alpine will support a DL Certified/ PL trained coach willing to commit to being PL certified by April 2026.
- Minimum 5 years of coaching experience in alpine ski racing, with a strong background in athlete development and program leadership.
- Knowledge of Para Alpine skiing classification.
- Proven ability to plan, deliver, and evaluate high-performance programs.
- Strong leadership, communication, and organizational skills.
- Experience with provincial or national-level competitions is a strong asset.
- Must reside in Saskatchewan or be willing to relocate as a condition of employment.
- Valid driver's license and willingness to travel regularly throughout the province and beyond.
